I acknowledge receiving from the NGAP Adoption Center custody of the above described animal, as to which I solemnly promise:

- 1) I will provide humane care and will comply with all laws and ordinances in force in the area in which I reside applicable to said animal.
- 2) I will report to the NGAP Adoption Center immediately if the Greyhound is lost, stolen or dead.
- 3) I will allow no one to use said animal for any experimental purpose whatsoever.
- 4) I will return said Greyhound to the NGAP Adoption Center if at anytime I desire to relinquish custody of it. I shall **NEVER** take said animal to an animal pound, shelter, or any other person or group without written permission from the NGAP.
- 5) I will return said animal to the NGAP Adoption Center if at anytime I am requested to do so by the NGAP ADOPTION CENTER because of any violation of the terms of this agreement, making no charge for its upkeep or for any other reason.
- 6) I agree that I will not attempt to hold the NGAP Adoption Center, or its staff and director responsible for any illness of the animal or for any damages which the animal may do to any person or property. I accept all future liability with regard to said animal.
- 7) I will not use said animal for the purpose of hunting game animals.
- 8) I will never allow said animal to be raced again.
- 9) I will return the follow up reports when they are due.
- 10) I will give my pet heartworm preventative.

- 11) I will submit photographs of my new pet once a year to NGAP for its use in finding more adoptive homes.
- 12) I will immediately obtain an identification tag for my greyhound showing my name, address and phone number in case my greyhound is lost.
- 13) I will **NEVER** allow my greyhound off a lead unless it is in a fenced area. If I am found to be endangering my greyhound by doing so, I will relinquish my greyhound to the adoption program upon request.
